

| TERM | ABBREVIATION <i>(spell out with first use, then abbreviate)</i> | DESCRIPTION |
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| Applied Physics Lab | APL | The nation's largest university-affiliated research center. |
| Center of Excellence Analytics Medicine Program | CAMP | A 12-week program that trains participants in the Precision Medicine Analytics Platform (PMAP). The program is a John Hopkins initiative to accelerate biomedical research by combining EMR, medical imaging, physiological monitoring, and genomics into a cloud-based big data platform. |
| Core for Clinical Research Data Acquisition | CCDA | Assists researchers with accessing clinical data for research purposes; staffed with experienced data analysts who will assist with access to data while also ensuring compliance with Data Trust privacy and security regulations. |
| Center of Excellence or Precision Medicine Center of Excellence | CoE (or PMCoE) | Formally designated units within JHM, generally engaged in clinical treatment and research of a specific disease. |
| Chesapeake Regional Information System for our Patients | CRISP | A regional health information exchange (HIE) serving Maryland and the District of Columbia. Formally designated as Maryland's statewide health information exchange by the Maryland Health Care Commission. |
| Clinical Research Management System | CRMS | Web-based tool to organize and streamline clinical research management; designed to improve communication among study team members. |
| Comma Separated Values | CSV | A delimited text file that uses a comma to separate values. Each line of the file is a data record. Each record consists of one or more fields, separated by commas. |
| Data Use Agreement | DUA | Legally binding contracts between a party and another executing party that provide the terms for transferring data from the provider organization to the recipient organization. |

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| Electronic Medical Record | EMR | The digital version of the paper charts in the clinician's office. An EMR contains the medical and treatment history of the patients in one practice. |
| Extract, Transform, Load | ETL | A process that extracts the data from different RDBMS source systems then transforms the data (like applying calculations, concatenations, etc.) and finally loads the data into the PMAP system. |
| Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resource | FHIR | A standard describing data formats and elements (known as "resources") and an application programming interface (API) for exchanging electronic health records. |
| Health Information Exchange | HIE | Allows clinical information to move electronically among disparate health information systems. |
| Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act | HIPAA | Requires the protection and confidential handling of protected health information. |
| Health Level Seven | HL7 | A set of international standards for the transfer of clinical and administrative data between software applications used by various healthcare providers |
| Institutional Review Board | IRB | Responsible for protecting the rights and welfare of the human subjects of research conducted by faculty and staff at the Institutions. |
| Johns Hopkins Health System | JHHS | Consists of Johns Hopkins Hospital, All Children's Hospital, Bayview Medical Center, Howard County General, Johns Hopkins Community Physicians, Johns Hopkins Medical Services Corp., and Johns Hopkins Medical Management Corp. |
| Johns Hopkins Medical Institute | JHMI | <i>see JHM</i> |
| Johns Hopkins Medicine | JHM | A collaboration between JHHS and JHU; a vehicle for internal operational coordination and a united voice for external initiatives. The main operational entities of JHM are Johns Hopkins HealthCare LLC and The Johns Hopkins Home Care Group, Inc. |
| Johns Hopkins University | JHU | The institution's name. |

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| Medical Record Number | MRN | Johns Hopkins Patient Identifier. |
| Picture Archiving & Communication System | PACS | The source for all medical imaging (e.g. MRIs, X-Rays, etc.) |
| Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute | PCORI | PCORI helps people make informed healthcare decisions, and improves healthcare delivery and outcomes, by producing and promoting high-integrity, evidence-based information that comes from research guided by patients, caregivers, and the broader healthcare community. |
| Principal Investigator | PI | Pertains to product development cycle and tracking incremental progress |
| Precision Medicine Analytics Platform | PMAP | Brings together revolutions in measurement, connectivity, and data science to enable the discovery of clinically-relevant and biologically-anchored subgroups at scale. |
| Software as a Service | SaaS | A software distribution model in which a third-party provider hosts applications and makes them available to customers over the Internet. |
| Extensible Markup Language | XML | A markup language that defines a set of rules for encoding documents in a format that is both human-readable and machine-readable. |
